- Permission to publish fees: When a decision is made to use a specific photograph for publication, please notify the Archivist and pay the fee unless it has been waived. Permission to publish is contingent on the receipt of this form and the fee.
- If in print, a copy of the publication containing the image(s) should be given to FHL as soon as the work has been published.
- FHL does not claim to control the rights of reproduction for pictorial material in its collections. The publishing party assumes all responsibility for clearing reproduction rights and for any infringement of the U.S. Copyright Code.
- Photographs may be cropped to suit design and layout, but they may not be altered or drawn upon so that they look in any way different from the way they appear in the collection.
- FHL reserves the right to refuse permission and/or provide image reproduction services to publishers and individuals who have not complied with its policies.
